



Colourful De Waterkant Village is a unique European influenced village of semi-detached quaint cottages and cobble streets preserved from the 1760's. Cradled between the city and the V&A Waterfront, De Waterkant Village is famously known as Cape Town's gateway to design, fashion, food and lifestyle with an abundance of restaurants, art galleries, clubs, tapas bars and Parisian inspired cafés.
